welcome to our site

On arriving at the site, please use this map to guide you to the parking areas. Once parked, the map will help you to familiarise yourself with the layout of the site and acts as a reference for all the useful information that you will need.

CAMPERVANS

Check in: after 1pm Check out: before midday

Please respect other guests and arrive quietly if you are arriving late.

Please park up in your numbered hard standing area and confirm which number before arrival if possible. Most electric hook up points are in the upper campground unless you have a larger campervan where we'll place you in the lower parking area by the site entrance to use points 7 or 8.

If you do not need a hookup we recommend parking higher up the campsite to avoid obstructing the view for tents. It is a very short walk to the facilities and the recycling point.

We can only accept campervans over 6m in length with prior arrangement.

CAMPING

Check in: after 1pm Check out: before midday

Please respect other guests and arrive quietly if you are arriving late.

Pitch up in either the lower or upper campground, there are levelled pitches. I recommend tents to pitch close to the sea view side of the campsite to avoid obstructions to your view.

It is a very short walk to the facilities and the recycling point.

PODS

Check in: after 3pm Check out: before 11am

If you would like bedding please check that you have ticked bedding as an extra on your booking.

On arrival you will see the timber pods at the top of the track. Please make yourself at home when you arrive, there is a key in your door.

Equipment and heating: the pods are provided with futons, blankets, lamps, electric sockets, kettle and mugs, hot water bottles and washing up bowls. They are heated with an electric radiator.

Each pod has up to 4 futon mattresses that fold up or roll up. We can provide a bedding for a couple on the futons together and this includes a double fitted sheet/ duvet/ pillows. Let us know otherwise singles will be provided.

The pods are 2.7m x 2m (8'10" x 6'6") and they fit up to 4 people on futons but 2 to 3 is better as you may need the floor space.

YURT

Check in: after 3pm Check out: before 11am

Please make yourself at home when you arrive (there is no key).

Equipment and heating: the yurts are provided with a double futon bed, an extra futon, blankets, washing up bowl, wood burning stove, cooking equipment, plates and bowls and cutlery. There will be a trug full of logs, kindling, firelight's and matches. Extra firewood is available on site.

PLEASE NOTE: if you need bedding (duvet, pillows) please make sure you order it when booking or call us before arrival.

There is no electricity in the yurts.

SHEPHERD'S HUTS

Check in: after 3pm Check out: before 11am Please make yourself at home when you arrive (there is no key).

Equipment and heating: the shepherd's huts are provided with king size double, an extra futon, blankets, washing up bowl, wood burning stove, cooking equipment, plates, bowls and cutlery. There will be a trug full of logs, kindling, firelight's and matches. Extra firewood is available on site.

PLEASE NOTE: if you need bedding (duvet, pillows) please make sure you order it when booking or call us before arrival.

There is no electricity in the shepherd's huts.

The Pentland Loft

Check in: after 3pm Check out: before 11am

Please make yourself at home when you arrive (there is no key).

The loft is a self contained self catering accommodation with a kitchen and has a loo with sink. The main shower facilities are 5 second walk from the front door.

Bedding and heating: the loft is provided with bedding for the double bed. Please bring sleeping bags for extra guests. If you would like extra duvets and pillows please order before arrival. There is a wood stove and two electric radiators.

Cottage

Check in: after 3pm Check out: before 11am

Please make yourself at home when you arrive (there is no key).

The cottage is a self contained self catering accommodation with its own facilities.

Bedding and heating: the cottage is provided with bedding for the double bed and has ground source under floor heating. A basket of wood will be provided for the Hikki hot tub outside and more wood is available in the camp shop on site.

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

If possible please do ask any questions you might have in advance of your arrival. I may not be able to answer questions immediately if you contact me when you arrive.

Directions: please save these directions – Wheems and Wild Orcadian is signposted on South Ronaldsay, look out for white signs with green borders with Wheems and Wild Orcadian.

Arrival: you don't need to visit reception unless you'd like to say hello/ need to pay your balance/ require anything.

Reception: reception is at the back door of our house. We live and work on site and should be around throughout the day on the farm, around the campsite or at the farmhouse from 9am to 9pm. Please ring our mobile 0772 005 3724 if no one is around and you need to speak to us.

Outstanding balances: please pay any outstanding balance by card or cash on arrival or during your stay.

Honesty shop & potted herb garden: we stock a range of local and whole foods – pasta, pulses, tins, snacks, sauces, tea, coffee chocolate etc, fresh eggs, bread and in season organic produce from the farm. Please put payment in the tins displayed. There is also a fridge with locals cheeses, butter and milk. Please help yourself to the herbs and salad leaves that we have planted for you. There is a watering can so if the plants look thirsty please feel free to help us water them!

Campers kitchen: basic but fully equipped open kitchen area with kettles, pots, pans, crockery, small oven, a microwave, 4 hobs, a fridge and a fridge freezer.

The sit ooterie: has a lovely inside outside feel with a wood stove (please light if you want to or ask for help). There is a book swap area and tables and benches for eating and also a communal pizza oven.

Shower block: 4 showers, 3 loos, 3 washing up sinks, washing machine (£2.50 including soap, honesty tin in by washing machine) and drying area.

Rubbish: we have general waste and variety of labelled recycling bins. We would ask that you recycle as much as possible before using the general waste to keep with our low impact, reuse campsite.

Fires and barbecues: are permitted provided they are raised off the ground so as not to kill the grass nor cause any fire hazard.

Dogs: please keep your dogs on leads at all times whilst on the campsite, we have ducks, chickens and a couple of Kune Kune pigs. Dogs must not be let off their leads on Orkney anywhere near livestock. The fields behind the house and campsite which are signed, are not for dogs due to being protected areas for wildlife and livestock. The dog poo bin is opposite the recycling point and is marked on the map. Please use only biodegradable poo bags. We have some if yours are not biodegradable – please take some from the shower block cupboard.

Toilet waste disposal: no chemical waste please this would cause a great risk to the organic status Wheems has maintained for 30 years. We only allow non-chemical disposal down a toilet in the shower block please.

It can be windy: please be aware that Orkney can sometimes get very windy being an island in the North Sea!
